CLEANING AND STORAGE

Clean lenses regularly with mild soapy water or Scope Aquaclean Plus range:

- **AC500:** 500 pre-moistened towelettes
- **AC100:** 100 pre-moistened towelettes
- **AC500CS:** Cleaning station (spray bottle + tissues).

Do not use alcohol/ammonia/propane based cleaners.

Outdoor Untinted

Outdoor Tinted

These eye protectors are intended for outdoor use where no optical radiation hazards exist other than solar radiation. They are intended to provide adequate protection against sun glare and ultraviolet radiation from the sun.

Lens Marking: I1, I2, or I3
